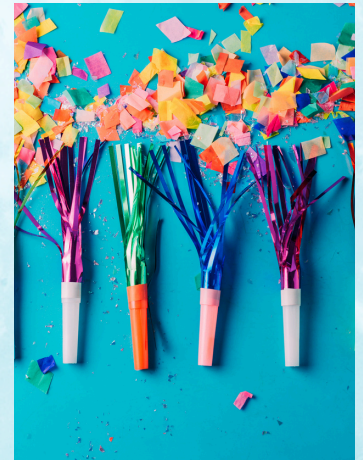


### Think Again! The Parables of Jesus: Your Place at the Party
