HISTORY & GOALS

Westminster Cooperative Preschool is a community outreach program of Westminster Presbyterian Church. It was established in 1972 to serve families in the Rogue Valley. The preschool welcomes children from all cultures and religious backgrounds.

Westminster Preschool strives to maintain a learning environment that reflects Christian values of love, acceptance, empathy and compassion for others. Weekly *Chapel Chats* are offered to all our preschool classes.

Westminster Preschool incorporates a curriculum that is based on developmentally appropriate practices. Its goals are to provide recreation and education for preschool children through a cooperative effort between teachers and parents.



Our Program

The teachers create an environment and activities that are developmentally appropriate, centering around the children's social, spiritual, emotional, physical, and cognitive needs.

- Chapel Chats to hear stories communicating that God loves us and that Jesus wants to be our friend forever
- Dramatic, sensory, and exploratory play with toys for fine motor development, pre-reading and pre-math skill building and enhancement of social skills
- Calendar time, story time, sharing, and singing
- Art experience with emphasis on process, not product
- Snack time for enjoying food and conversation together
- Active play outside on our playground to exercise and develop large motor skills



GUIDELINES

- Westminster Preschool is a parent cooperative. An adult family member should be available to help in the classroom approximately once every three weeks.
- All classroom volunteers must pass a criminal background check.
- All preschoolers are expected to be fully toilet trained and up to date on their immunizations.
