Sunday School for 6th-9th Grade at 10:45am Service Starting this Sunday!

Scripture tells us that the church is the body of Christ. All types of people and ages who are connected to Christ are united through the Holy Spirit. It is our goal to reflect this united reality in the tangible practices of the life of our church -- from Sunday worship to weekly programs.



To reach out towards, include, see, and empower 6th-9th graders to be part of this church family, our church is launching a new, ongoing class for **6th-9th graders at the 10:45am service beginning this Sunday, March 22**. We are calling it Empower, since the goal is to empower these students to be connected with the larger church family, to empower them with an interactive lesson on the same topic as the Sunday sermon, and empower them to find where their gifts and passions can make a difference in the church on Sunday and the church serving the community.

Here are a few details: We will dismiss at the same time as Surge, so 6th-9th grade will still join us in the Sanctuary. We will follow the Surge schedule -- taking the 1st Sunday of the month off in order to be included in communion. A note for parents: this is optional. While part of our purpose is to help teens see one another, and find a way to join in with their skills... if you think your student better tracks with service in the sanctuary, we trust your judgement call on if you would like them to remain with you. One of the most important factors for a faith that sticks beyond graduating high school, is regular participation in Sunday worship and finding belonging and purpose in the larger church mission. It is our goal that once someone is in 10th grade, for them to practice this rhythm for a "sticky faith".
