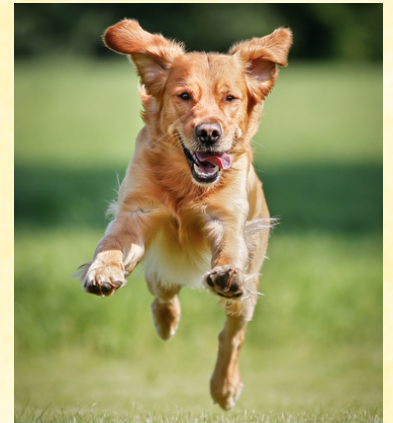
EXILES: LEAD INTO GOOD
