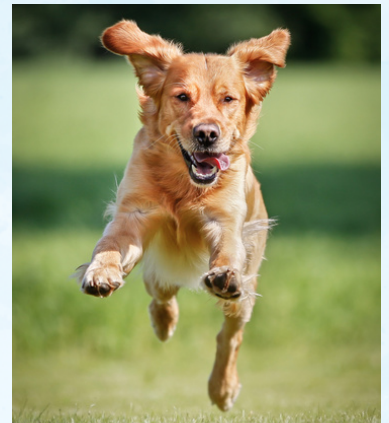
WALK WITH ME: FRIENDSHIP, FORMATION AND LEGACY
