Spiritual friendship can help us grow, even as we help shape the lives of others. But what happens when jealousy, fear, or rivalry gets in the way?

This week we'll look at the striking contrast between Saul and Jonathan in their relationships with David. Saul, the first anointed king of Israel, had the opportunity to encourage and invest in the man God was raising up next, but instead saw David as a threat. In contrast, his son Jonathan recognized God's work in David, committed himself to friendship, strengthened David in faith, and willingly made room for God's purposes.

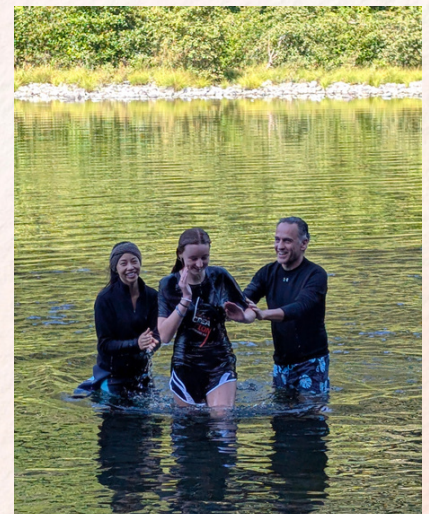
FALL WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY
